Program Details Cont.

- To begin the inquiry process, an application must be completed to determine your eligibility. Availability, rates and eligibility vary by state and circumstances.
- There are options available in 38 states. Availability, rates and eligibility vary by state and circumstances.

*States that only allow for their own state-run insurance program and certain limitations, do not allow outside parties to offer options within the state. States include Alaska, California, Connecticut, Hawaii, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island, Vermont and Washington.

Program Details Cont.

- This is not a service to help navigate the process of selecting a plan (Exchange or Off-Exchange). It is designed to help you understand the designs and premiums outside of the plan.
- The policy contract is between you and the insurance company. GCSAA does not come into possession of the policy or any protected health information.

17

Enrollment

- If you are insured through your employer, you will typically need to wait until the group policy renewal date to make a change.
- If you are experiencing a qualifying event (e.g., loss of affordable care Act policy (on or off the Exchange), divorce, etc.) you can enroll at any time during the year, pending your state's underwriting guidelines.
- If you are eligible and/or receiving government assistance, you are eligible for an option through this program.




Meet Alyssa.






