### Enrollment

- If you are insured through your employer, you will typically need to wait until the group plan is up for renewal to make a change.
- If you are experiencing a qualifying event (e.g., loss of coverage, new employment, etc.) or if you have a special enrollment period, you can enroll in a plan during the year, pending your eligibility based on the underwriting guidelines.
- If you are eligible and/or receiving government assistance, you can enroll either through Medicaid or an ACA/Obamacare plan. You are eligible for an option through this program.
